## Oak Park Townhouses Rules and Regulations for Pool & Sauna

- There is no lifeguard at any time. Use of the pool and pool area is at your own risk.
- The pool is for residents.
- Individuals aged <u>16 and older</u> are allowed at the pool. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Babies and toddlers must wear specific swim diapers. Normal diapers are not allowed due to sanitary purposes.
- Proper swimwear is required for use of the pool and sauna.
- The use of deck chairs and tables is on a first-come first serve basis.
- Running, rough housing or horseplay is not allowed.
- No bicycles, motorized toys, skateboards or similar items are allowed in the pool area.
- No diving into the pool is allowed.
- No pets of any kind are allowed in the pool area or the pool.
- Food and beverages are allowed in the pool area but not inside the pool. No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area. Please clean up after yourself.
- No alcohol is allowed in the pool area.
- Absolutely no smoking or vaping around the pool or within the facilities.
- No personal barbecues are to be brought to the pool area.
- Very important -Please use waterproof or water resistance suntan lotion only.
   Absolutely no baby oil. Baby oil/lotion/etc. are very damaging to the pool water and equipment.
- Please shower prior to use of pool or sauna. Showers are located in the bathrooms of the east entrance of the rec room.
- Anyone not able to swim on his or her own is required to wear a life jacket or similar device.
- The pool and sauna cannot be rented for private use.
- No electrical items are permitted in the pool area except by the use of maintenance personnel.
- Please limit your guests to 4 people. Residents must accompany guests.
- The pool divider must always be connected across the pool, unless you are swimming laps. If you move the divider, please return it when your laps are completed.

Any person not observing the pool and sauna rules will receive a warning letter. Further infractions will result in their key to the pool being confiscated.
